Student Attendance Cards

What is the purpose of the student attendance card?

Professor AJ Scales would like the students to have a visual representation of attendance and their progress for their possible promotion leading up to a promotion day. Please be aware that attendance is only one aspect that is considered when promoting. Behaviour, respect, focus, participation and knowledge comprehension also weigh into the decision.


When do the students get promoted?

Promotions are awarded quarterly. Students must attend **eighteen classes** for a <u>possible</u> promotion. All students <u>must attend</u> the scheduled promotion day in order to receive their earned promotion.

How do the attendance cards work?

Each student is responsible for pulling their attendance card and having it ready for the coach to collect at the beginning of class. The coach will then have their attendance recorded on the card. Students are also responsible for ensuring their cards are taken care of while in their possession (ie, not being bent up, lost, ink rubbed off, etc.)

Example of an attendance card and how the attendance accrues:



Legend:

BLACK = Regular Class

GREEN = Promotion Day

RED = Credits applied

BLUE = Class cancellation for competition

Working on earning:

- **Stripe #1** Student will recieve promotion based on attendance and discretion of coaches.
- **Stripe #2** Student missed 3 classes. A private class credit was applied for possible promotion.
- **Stripe #3** Student will recieve promotion based on attendance and discretion of coaches.
- **Stripe #4** Student missed 4 classes. Competition credits were applied for possible promotion.
- **New Belt** Student missed 4 classes. Coaches will assess Jonny's progress over the calendar year for possible promotion.
